Creditors and Accruals as at 30 September 2023 comprised £315.00 in respect of the costs of the tour of the Garrick Club's paintings, a £300.00 accrual for the costs of the September 2023 Newsletter (No 45), and £11,954.48 for A & J Robertson Granite Ltd's final account for the restoration of Rattigan's family grave in Kensal Green Cemetery.
